

How to do Math Test Corrections

In order to improve your math test score, you may do test corrections to earn half the points back. For example, if you got a 70%, if all of your test corrections are done correctly and turned in on time, you could earn 15% toward your grade.

Important Information:

- Tests are on Fridays
- When you receive your test back, you have **two days to make corrections**. For example, if you receive your graded test on Monday, corrections are due Wednesday. **I do not accept late test corrections.**
- DO NOT do test corrections on your test!
- Test Corrections should be written out on notebook paper in the following way:
 - Name, #, Date and Test Corrections for Week of _____.
 - Write the number of each problem and **copy** the problem down.
 - Show ALL work
 - Label your answer if needed
 - Circle Your Answer
- Staple your corrections to your Test and turn in by the due date. **NO LATE CORRECTIONS ARE ACCEPTED!**
