Electronics/Phones

Electronics/Phones can be a big distraction in class. Monroe students are not allowed to use their personal electronic devices on campus unless specifically required by the classroom teacher.

The basic rule is: until a student is given permission to use their own device in class on any given day, they should be turned off and out of sight.

What to Expect:

Students will be using Schoology, a learning management system to find their assignments, track their grades and turn in their work when it is required to do so virtually. Students will also have work done in class. Some assignments completed in class will be turned in to the black box by the door in the appropriate period.

Chromebook Rules:

Chromebooks are used daily in the classroom and are expected to be brought to school everyday, fully charged. Students are expected to use only their assigned Chromebook. There is no drinking of any beverage near the Chromebooks. Please keep water bottles on the floor or in your backpack when Chromebooks are out.

Each student is expected to use the Chromebook only for class purposes. GoGuardian is an app that I use that shows all students' screens and internet history (it also lets students chat with me). It will be running all day during class. I will have to lock any student's computer screen if they are off task.

Physical Education – P.E.

P.E. is a daily class. Students are expected to wear footwear that is appropriate for participating in sports and activities outside. Students are expected to participate to the best of their ability, showing effort and a willingness to learn. Reusable water bottles are suggested because water fountains are closed due to COVID restrictions.

Grades:

Students are expected to meet deadlines for assignments, just as in any real-world production. There will be a deadline date, if students miss that date, they may turn in their work by the "Drop Dead" date, which is 2 weeks later, after that they receive a 50% F. Students will have points deducted for missing a deadline.

Grades are based on total points earned. Rubrics are sometimes used to grade assignments. Assignments are not weighted separately unless specified.

Students are expected to make up work missed. There will be opportunities to work after school or lunch, if necessary, by appointment.

Checking Grades - PowerSchool

While students can monitor their grades on Schoology. PowerSchool will house the final grades that will appear on the report cards. Students will be given access to their PowerSchool account and the ability to track and review their grades on a regular basis. Parents will receive a code also, usually on back to school night
